TIME: 8:30am-11:00am

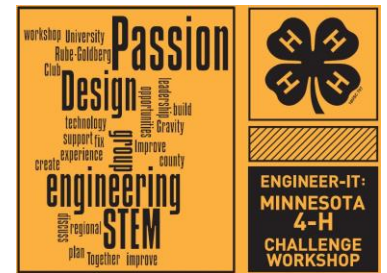
